NORTH SHORELAND PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OUTLOT #1

- 1. The outlot may be used by member property owners and guests under their control. The Board, or any member, reserves the right to ask any person for identification.
- 2. All members and dock owners using the outlot shall abide by all rules and regulations, and will be responsible for informing their guests of the same.
- 3. Boats placed at docking facilities must comply with regulations regarding Illinois Dept. Of Conservation registration, the Lake of Egypt, as specified by the Southern Illinois Power Cooperative (SIPC), and the North Shoreland Property Owners Association's "Boat Dock Access and Use Agreement".
- 4. Members and their guests shall, when using any pavilion, boat ramp, dock, or other facility on or around the outlot, leave it clean and in proper order. No debris, garbage, etc. shall be left after each use of the outlot.
- 5. All fires shall be confined to fireplaces, grills, or other proper containers (i.e. not on the ground), and shall be fully extinguished when not in use and the ashes removed.
- 6. All vehicles shall be parked on gravel area when weather causes the ground to be soft.
- 7. Members shall avoid parking cars where it may block the outlot access driveway or boat ramp.
- 8. No boat trailers may be parked on the outlot overnight.
- 9. Boats may not be parked at the boat ramp dock so as to block other boats from being launched.
- 10. At no time shall boats, jet skis, or any type of marine craft be tied to trees on the outlot.
- 11. No boats, other than those of boat dock owners, may remain attached to the outlot for more than fourteen (14) days in a calendar year. Any boats, other than dock owners' boats, must be owned by a guest of a North Shoreland property owner and be tied at the community dock, or at a location specified by the North Shoreland Property Owners Assn. until such dock is constructed.
- 12. Members desiring to use the outlot for parties, meetings, reunions, etc., shall schedule such occurrence in advance with the Chairman of the Outlot Committee. All such occurrences shall end at 9:00 P.M. promptly, so as not to disturb nearby residents.
- 13. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs shall be consumed on the outlot. Proper legal authorities will be summoned should this rule be violated.
